National Curriculum

As Geographers we will be using maps, atlases and globes (physical and digital) to investigate how we're connected to the oceans and to locate environmental issues, focusing on Australia.

<u>In French</u> we will be learning the names of animals.

<u>As Artists</u> we will be investigating Indigenous Australian designs and improving our graphical presentation.

<u>As Musicians</u> we will be composing and performing using the cornet and developing our appreciation of a wider range of music. (Mr. Pritchard)

<u>As Scientists</u> we will explore animal classification and changing habitats.

<u>In Computing</u> we will be combining images and music to create short films and using Keynote to support our Science.

<u>In RE</u> we will be exploring what Christians believe is meant by the Kingdom of God and why Pentecost is so important to them.

As athletes we will be developing our agility, co-ordination and teamwork, including fielding and striking games.

<u>In Drama</u> we will focusing on devising and expressing ideas, creative story-telling, mime, action and freeze frames, in the context of Roald Dahl stories.

<u>In PSHE</u> we will be exploring the importance of relationships, how they change and how to manage difficulties, including grief.

<u>As Writers</u> we will be exploring and designing a variety of non-fiction texts, including biographies. We will also begin to develop persuasive arguments.

<u>As Mathematicians</u> we will be improving our skills of twostep problem solving, and learning about decimals, time and money.
