Use the internet to find out some interesting facts about The Great Fire of London. Write them down and choose your favourite one to share with the class.

Samuel Pepys was famous for writing a diary. Write a diary for one weekend. Include the different things you do and see.

Birds from around the world - research ten birds which come from different countries. Name the birds, the country and the continent which they come from.

Measure your wingspan (stretch out your hands and ask an adult to measure you). Then find a bird with the same wingspan as you.

Find out some fun bird facts —choose a bird to research. What is its habitat? What is its diet? Where is it from?

Create an alphabetical list of different birds. Don't worry if you can't find a bird for every letter.

Draw and label your favourite bird. Use adjectives to describe your picture.

Create a fat ball for the birds in your garden.

Bird watching - sit in your garden or look out of your window and see what birds you can see. Can you find out the species of birds you have found? Write them down in a list. Can you create a tally chart?

Practise your spellings.
Practise counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s.
