**2D Shapes** - go on a shape hunt at home. Name the shapes you find and talk about their properties - how many sides and vertices do they have? Does your shapes have a vertical line of symmetry? Draw the shapes you find (or take photographs), list their properties and draw on their vertical line of symmetry.

**Research** - there are lots of different breeds of penguins in the world. Create a list of different penguins.

**Christmas Play Practise** - We will be busy over the next few weeks practising for our Christmas Play. Please practise your words and know your cues ready for a terrific performance!

Choose one of the penguins from the list you have created and write down some interesting facts.



**Design** your own bird - what will it look like? What will it eat? Will a creature hunt your bird? Can it fly, run or swim? Draw a picture of your bird and label it.

**Story** - Write a story about a bird on a journey. Where will it go on? What will happen to it? Will it be a happy ending? Remember to use expanded noun phrases, verbs, adverbs and conjunctions.

**Food chains** - What do different birds eat? What creatures eat birds? Create a couple of food chains using different types of birds.



**Geography** - Many penguins come from Antarctica. Find out ten fascinating facts about the continent.

**Internet** - why can't penguins fly? Use the internet or non-fiction books to help you answer this question.

Practise your reading, spellings and counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s a few times every week.

**Time** - Practise telling the time using the terms, o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to.

**Nouns** - nouns name a person, place or thing. We use collective nouns to name groups of things. Can you find out different collective nouns for different birds?
