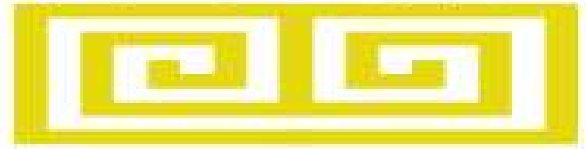


Lynders Homework
