English:

This term most of our writing will be themed on our topic. The general outline for our English lessons will be to explore a style of writing, through drama, discussions and exciting examples, then plan our writing during the first week followed by editing and writing up an extended piece over the course of the second week.

Spellings: The children will be receiving spelling lists to learn including some high frequency words and some that include the sound we are doing in phonics. These will be given out on Monday and normally tested on the following Monday.

Mathematics:

In maths this term we will be recapping place value within 10. Then addition and subtraction within 10 ending with shape. While many of the children are capable of working beyond ten we will be using this time to introduce the new methods and representations they will be using later in year 1.

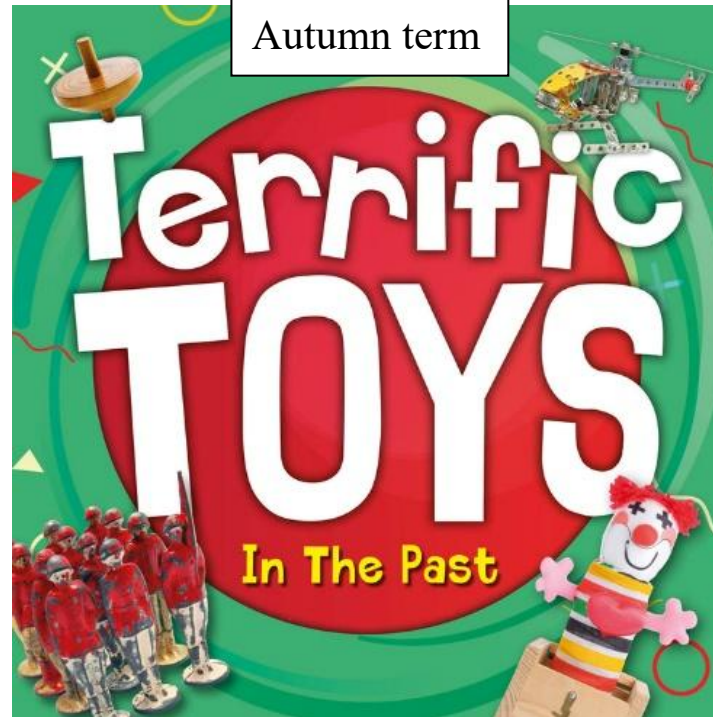
Science:

Physical development: P.E. lessons will be on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons. During these sessions, we will be developing your child's basic movement and sportsmanship skills. We will also regularly be going on runs in the afternoon during which the children are encouraged to run, march or walk quickly for 10 minutes.
